

2014 HUNTING AND FISHING QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

HUNTING

Q: When can I buy a hunting license for 2014?

A: Hunting licenses will be available for purchase on June 9, 2014

Q: When can I apply for Doe tags?

A: The first day of sale is July 14, 2014 for residents and July 28th for non-residents. Applications accepted thru the mail only.

Q: Can I get more than one doe tag?

A: Yes, first round of unsold will begin August 4, 2014 by mail and the second round of unsold will be August 18, 2014 by mail. They will be available until the particular WMU is sold out. Check your Hunting Digest for the dates that "over the counter sales" begin.

Q: Where can I get a timely WMU breakdown of remaining unsold antlerless deer licenses?

A: At website www.pgc.state.pa.us and under "Quick Clicks", click on the Doe License Update link to be directed to a table that provides the latest and regularly updated information on the availability of antlerless deer licenses in all WMUs.

Q: I have a lifetime license. Do I have to renew every year?

A: Yes. It is only for the purpose of issuing an application for an antlerless deer tag. You will not have to purchase a new license.

Q: How can I obtain information about Hunter-Trapper Education classes in my area?

A: Refer to the Hunter and Trapper Education section of this home page www.pgc.state.pa.us and click on the county you desire information on.

Q: If I lose my license, what do I do?

A: You may purchase a replacement license for from any issuing agent or on-line. Lost Doe tags may be replaced only by County Treasurers.

Q: What are the Military discounts?

A: To qualify for the reduced fee license for \$2.70 applicants must:

- Be a resident of this commonwealth
- Be on active and full- time duty in the U.S Armed Forces
- Be currently assigned to a facility outside this commonwealth
- Be on temporary leave inside the commonwealth

Reduced fee \$2.70 general hunting license are also available for residents serving in the PA National Guard and Reserves who, within the previous 24 months, were deployed overseas for a period of 60 consecutive days or more, or were released early because of injuries or disease incurred in the line of duty.

Q: What about free licenses for Disabled Vets ?

A: Resident disabled war veterans with service- incurred 100% disability, or the loss of use of one or more limbs, may qualify for free hunting and furtaker licenses.

*Applicants must show proof of residency by driver's license or other documentation.

*Must show they are a disabled vet. The only acceptable written documentation is Certified from the U.S .Department of Veteran Affairs.

FISHING

Q: Are fishing licenses available to purchase now?

A: Yes.

Q: How long is the license valid?

A: Licenses and permits with the exception of 1-day Tourist, 3-Day Tourist, 7-day Tourist, 1-day Resident and Resident Lifetime Licenses are valid for up to 13 months including the year printed on the license and the month of December of the prior year.

Q: How old do I have to be to get a Senior license?

A: You may purchase a Senior Resident license anytime in the calendar year that you turn 65 years old. The same goes for a Senior Resident Lifetime.

Q: Can I get a One Day license?

A: Yes if you are a bona fide resident and only for one 24-hour period. You must specify the date and time you wish to issue it and it will be valid for that time period only. You also will not be able to have one for the period of March 15th thru April 30th.

Q: If I lose my license can I get a replacement?

A: Yes. All license types may be replaced. Replacement licenses include all previously purchased stamps or permits.

Q: I am in the Military. Do I get a discount?

A: Eligible active duty military personnel can fish legally without a license under limited circumstances outlined in the law. To be eligible you must be:

- A bona fide resident of Pennsylvania
- Be on active duty , stationed outside Pennsylvania and be here on authorized leave.

Must carry proof of each of those requirements such as a PA drivers license, his or her military ID and valid military orders showing his or her place of assignment and leave status while fishing. It is also recommended that you display your military ID while fishing.

Q:I am a Disabled Veteran. Do I get a free fishing license?

A: To qualify for a free fishing license, an applicant must:

- Be a bona fide resident of Pennsylvania and qualify as one of the following:
 1. Be 100% disabled as certified by the United States Dept. of Veteran Affairs.
Or
 2. Have a disability incurred in any war or armed conflict consisting of:
 - Loss of one or more limbs
 - Loss of use of one or more limbs
 - Total blindness
- Must show proof of residency by driver's license or other documentation.
- Must show they are a disabled vet. The only acceptable documentation is certified from the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs.

A Trout- Salmon permit will be issued free of charge to disabled veterans who qualify for free fishing licenses.

Q: Is there a discount for National Guard?

A: You must first provide documentation that within the previous 24 months you were deployed overseas as a member of the National Guard or the reserve component of the armed forces for a period of 180 consecutive days or more, or that you were released early from service because of an injury or disease incurred in the line of duty.

In addition to fishing license requirements , Pennsylvania law provides that certain permits are required for the privilege to fish in certain waters or for specific species of fish.

Examples would be :Trout/ Salmon permit or Lake Erie permit.

Please check with the handbook or with the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission for details.
