-Mercury containing devices \$3.25/pound
-Propane Tanks/Fire Extinguishers \$15

BATTERIES - Alkaline/Rechargeable 50 cents/pound
BATTERIES - Lead Acid 20 cents/pound

FLUORESCENT LIGHTS - Compact \$1
FLUORESCENT LIGHTS - 4' and less \$1
FLUORESCENT LIGHTS - 5' and up \$2
HIGH INTENSITY DISCHARGE LIGHTS \$2

APPLIANCES - Freon-containing: \$20
-refrigerators, air-conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.

APPLIANCES - All others: \$5
-washers, hot-water tanks, stoves, etc.

TIRES - Passenger Vehicle: \$2
TIRES - Light Truck: \$5
TIRES - Passenger/LT On Rims: \$10
TIRES - Tractor Trailer: \$10
TIRES - Tractor Trailer on Rims: \$20
LIMIT—12 Tires per Person

Payment for **ELECTRONICS AND HAZARDOUS WASTE** will be made directly to our contractor, Environmental Coordination Services & Recycling (ECS&R). **ECS&R accepts cash, check, or credit card.**

Payment for **APPLIANCES and TIRES** will be made to Tri-County CleanWays (TCC). TCC accepts cash only, day of event. No personal checks accepted, no exceptions. TCC will accept business checks but cannot accept personal checks.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS (Do not bring items that are broken, need repaired, or are unusable.)

ANIMAL ITEMS: Dog and Cat Crates, Cages, Collars and Leashes, Metal Food Bowls, Dog and Cat Toys, Litter Boxes, etc.

BEDDING & BATH ITEMS: Bath towels, washcloths, hand towels, bath mats, blankets, dressers, end tables.

GENERAL HOUSEHOLD ITEMS: Clothing/shoes, accessories (e.g. handbags, belts, scarves), furniture, radios, clocks, lamps, etc.

KITCHEN ITEMS: Kitchen utensils, measuring cups, set of dishes, set of glassware, services bowls, silverware, tables and chairs.

MEDICAL SUPPLIES: Bandages/dressings bariatric commodes and scrubs (new or gently used up to XL) canes, crutches, hoier lifts, lift/transport chairs, wheelchairs, nebulizers (no accessories unless new and in package), wheel chairs, rollator/wheeled walkers, shower seats, tub transfer benches, etc.

MEDIA: Books, DVDs, CDs, Records Cassette Tapes

USABLE BUILDING MATERIALS: Doors, light fixtures, lumber (4'+), windows, etc.

VINTAGE ITEMS: Jewelry, antiques, etc.
