### Introduction

The directory is organized into three primary sections.

1. "Municipal Drop-off and Curbside Programs" listed alphabetically by municipality, phone numbers, materials collected, places, dates, and times of collection.
2. "Listing by Materials" The list is arranged by material. It tells where materials can be recycled.
3. "Alphabetical List of Recyclers" list recyclers in alphabetical order, including their address, telephone number, and material accepted.

### When You Shop:

Packaging makes up more than 30% of consumer waste and uses 10 cents of every shopping dollar. Become an environmentally aware shopper and avoid buying over-packaged products which add to our waste disposal problem.

- Buy durable goods
- Repair and restore used items
- Buy items you can reuse
- Avoid excess packaging
- Buy items made from recycled materials

### At Work and School:

- Start simply. Reduce waste by using both sides of the paper for copying and memos
- Recycle office paper, aluminum cans, leaves and corrugated cardboard.

#### **Remember, it's the law!**

- Use reusable coffee mug
- Buy only what you need
- Do a waste audit to see what you are throwing away. **Remember you pay for waste twice, once when you purchase it and second to throw it away.**

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CURBSIDE RECYCLING

### **What is “Curbside Recycling?”**

Curbside recycling is simply having recyclables picked up at your home. It does not mean that a physical “curb” is required.

### **Am I required to recycle curbside?**

All residents and businesses of the following municipalities are required by state and local laws to recycle curbside:

*City of New Castle*                      *Ellwood City Borough*                      *Neshannock Township,*  
*Shenango Township*                      *Union Township*

These are called “Mandated Municipalities.”

Residents and businesses in *New Wilmington Borough* are required to recycle curbside by local laws.

Residents and businesses of all other Lawrence County municipalities are not required to recycle curbside, but are encouraged to do so voluntarily. See “I live in a Municipality where I am not required to Recycle Curbside, but I would like to do so. What options do I have for curbside recycling?” for more information.

### **What can I recycle?**

Most recycling programs in Lawrence County collect recyclables via “single stream” recycling.

Single stream recycling is designed to make recycling as easy as possible for residents.

All of the materials listed below can be mixed together in the same container. There is no need to separate them.

The following materials are usually included in single stream recycling programs:

- #1 - #7 Plastic Bottles & Containers
- Clear & Colored Glass Bottles/Jars
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel/Tin Cans
- Magazines
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Newspaper
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- Junk Mail

If it is not on the list - it belongs in the trash or recycled elsewhere. This directory is a good place to start for finding other recycling options. Remember, if it is not on this list it will NOT get recycled when it gets to a recycling center.

## **What are the advantages of a curbside recycling program over a drop-off recycling program?**

Curbside Recycling is:

**EASY** - All materials can be mixed together in the same container.

**CONVENIENT** - You can do it at your own home without making a special trip to a recycling site.

**ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY** - No more using your gas to go to a recycling site.

## **I live in a municipality where I am not required to recycle curbside, but I would like to do so. What options do I have for curbside recycling?**

Effective October 9, 2014, all haulers providing regular trash collection services are required to provide recycling services to residents that request it but do not live in a Mandated Municipality. This requirement is for haulers only. Residents are not required to request the service and may decline it if offered. There may be additional fees for recycling. To summarize: if you want to recycle curbside at your home, your hauler must provide you with the service.

## **What kind of recycling bin can I use for curbside recycling?**

Recycling bins vary. Some haulers and municipalities will provide you with a container.

You can also purchase your own container through a local hardware or department store. Wheeled containers and carts are easy to move and provide adequate room for all your recyclables. Traditional bins may be used as well.

## **What about Polystyrene (Styrofoam), Toys, Windows, etc.?**

These items are trash. Plain and simple.

Including items not listed for recycling contaminates your recyclables and significantly increases the cost because all contaminates must be removed before the material can be recycled. None of these items will get recycled at a recycling center!

## **What about Leaves?**

All Mandated Municipalities, including New Wilmington, offer leaf waste collection. Contact your municipality for details.

## **What about Plastic Bags?**

Plastic bags do not belong in your recycle bin and will not get recycled if you include them. In fact, plastic bags are a major problem at recycling centers as they must be ripped open to free the recyclables and they result in the shutting down of recycling equipment, often multiple times daily.

# HOW TO PREPARE RECYCLABLES

## MATERIALS

### NEWSPAPER

Dry Newspaper

### GLOSSY MAGAZINES

Magazines with glossy covers and pages

### METAL CANS

Aluminum, steel, tin, and bi-metal food and beverage cans. Empty aerosol and paint cans

### GLASS

Clear, green, and brown glass food & beverage containers

### PLASTIC BOTTLES

**ONLY** plastic bottles with a narrow neck and a #1 or #2 in the recycling symbol on the bottom

### CARDBOARD - corrugated

### FIBERBOARD

Examples: cereal boxes, tissue boxes

### \*MOTOR OIL

Used vehicle motor oil

### \*APPLIANCES

Refrigerators, stove, air conditioners, washers, dryers, hot water tanks

### \*BATTERIES

All car and truck batteries

### \*TIRES

### PAINT CANS

Handle battery carefully, it contains acid.

Remove tire rims

Put unused paint in kitty litter. The paint will dry and harden. Recycle the paint can and discard the paint with the kitty litter.

## HOW TO PREPARE

Keep clean and dry stack together and place in a paper grocery bag

Keep clean and dry

Empty and rinse carefully flatten, paint cans and aerosols must be empty

Rinse, remove lids, **DO NOT BREAK**

Rinse, remove lids and plastic rings, flatten  
\*Check with your specific program if plastic tubs and lids are acceptable.

Flatten, keep dry and remove plastic taping

Flatten, keep dry

Collect oil in a clean container

Have Freon removed by a certified technician, **DO NOT** damage refrigerant tubing, **DO NOT** release into the air

## DO NOT INCLUDE

Catalogs, phone books, unwanted mail, plastic wrappers

Phone books, Reader's Digest, TV Guide, other non-shiny magazines

Foil, plastic lids, scrap metal, (food residue)

Ceramics, mirrors, crystal, milk glass, dishes, light bulbs TV tubes, window & auto glass

Ice cream buckets, yogurt containers, plastic lids, pesticide & chemical containers, plastics with code number 3-7.

**DO NOT** include boxes contaminated by food waste

Same as cardboard

**DO NOT MIX** with any other liquid, do not pour down storm drains, on ground or in water

# What to do with paint?



1. When purchasing paint, buy only what you need. Quarts are more expensive than gallons. However, if you only need a quart, don't buy a gallon that you will probably never use and need to dispose of down the road.
2. Use paint hardeners. This product comes in a small packet that when mixed with waste paint, solidifies the paint in about 20 minutes. Paint hardeners are available through many hardware and paint stores. Once the paint is solidified, you can toss it into the trash. Just make sure the lid is kept off of the can so that your trash hauler can see no liquid is present.
3. Pour your old paint onto kitty litter or another absorbent material. Once dry, the paint can be placed in your trash and you can recycle the can.
4. Use one of the ECS&R (Environmental Coordination Services & Recycling) drop-off sites in Crawford or Butler County. Contact them at 1-866-815-0016. The Crawford County site is open from 9 AM – 4 PM Monday through Friday. The Butler County site is by appointment only ([www.recyclebutler.us](http://www.recyclebutler.us)). Both of these sites also accept electronics and other hazardous materials. Fees apply.
5. Take it to a Southwestern PA Household Hazardous Waste Task Force collection event. These are scheduled periodically throughout the spring and fall seasons, at various locations. More information can be found at [www.zerowastepgh.org](http://www.zerowastepgh.org).
6. Quantities of good usable paint may be of interest to organizations (such as play houses or Habitat for Humanity) and schools for theatrical productions and other activities.

# Medication/Drug Disposal for Lawrence & Mercer Counties

## Overview

Medicines play an important role in treating many conditions and diseases, but when they are no longer needed it's important to dispose of them properly to avoid harm to others and the environment.

## Medicine Take-Back Programs

Medicine take-back programs for disposal are a good way to remove expired, unwanted, or unused medicines from the home and reduce the chance that others may accidentally take the medicine. You can talk to your pharmacist to see if he or she knows of other medicine disposal programs in your area or visit the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration's website for information on National Prescription Drug Take-Back Events.

## How Proper Disposal of Medications Protects You and the Environment

- Avoids health problems from accidentally taking the wrong medicine, too much of the same medicine, or a medicine that is too old to work well.
- Prevents poisoning of children and pets.
- Deters misuse by teenagers and adults.
- Keeps medicines from entering streams and rivers when poured down the drain or flushed down the toilet

## Using a Drop-off Location

All pharmaceutical drugs that are being disposed of need to be in a sealed container such as the original bottle or a zip-lock bag. They may not be disposed of loosely.

Liquid pharmaceuticals should remain in the original container.

Personal information should be removed or blotted out with a permanent marker.

## Items Accepted

Prescription and over-the-counter solid medications, tablets and capsules, liquid medications, inhalers, creams, ointments, nasal sprays, and pet medicines\*

## Items NOT Accepted

Intravenous solutions, injectables and needles\*
