ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this *6th* day of October, 2017, in accordance with Pennsylvania Rule of Judicial Administration No. 65(B)(6), it is hereby ORDERED AND DECREED that all filings originating in Hickory Township, Plain Grove Township, Scott Township, Shenango Township, Washington Township and South New Castle Boro, the venue of Magisterial District Court (MDC) 53-3-03, shall be transferred to and heard in Magisterial District Court (MDC) 53-3-04. Filings in Slippery Rock Township, also MDC 53-3-03, shall be transferred to and heard in Magisterial District Court (MDC) 53-3-01. Payments may continue to be made at the MDC 53-3-03 office until 10:00 a.m. on November 29, 2017, after which time all payments must be made at the MDC 53-3-04 office, with the exception of cases originating in Slippery Rock Township payments for which must be made at the MDC 53-3-01 office. The MDC 53-3-03 office shall close as of the close of business on November 29, 2017.

The effective date for the above change of venue shall be November 1, 2017.
