

CITY OF NEW CASTLE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of New Castle are required by state and local laws to recycle at their curb.

Materials Collected (*residential only*):

- Glass **bottles and jars**,
- Metal **cans** (including empty aerosol and paint cans with the lids removed)
- Plastic **bottles & jugs**
- Corrugated cardboard
- Magazines
- Newspapers, including inserts
- Mixed office paper
- Junk mail

Please note that only bottles, jars, and cans are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not include other items such as windows, toys, tubing, etc.

Businesses must also recycle, but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

There is a limit of three (3) recycling bins.

Any material placed on the ground (not in a bin) will not be picked up.

How: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: Once per month. The schedule is as follows:

If Your Garbage Day is:

Monday

Tuesday

Wednesday

Thursday

Then Your Recycling Day is:

1st Friday of the month

2nd Friday of the month

1st Friday of the month

2nd Friday of the month

Remember some months have 5 Fridays. There are no pickups on 5th Fridays.

Spring/Fall Cleanup: No

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: No.

Leaves & Yard Waste (excluding grass): Yes, collected weekly in late fall. Collected the rest of the year by appointment.

Christmas Trees: Yes. Collected in January. Residents purchase \$5 tag at Mayor's Office in the City Building.
