Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of New Wilmington are required to recycle at their curb.

Materials Collected:

- Glass food/beverage **bottles and jars**,
- Aluminum, steel, and tin **cans**
- Plastic **bottles & jugs**
- Corrugated cardboard
- Magazines
- Newspapers, including inserts
- Mixed office paper
- Junk mail

Please note that only bottles, jars, cans, and clean paper are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not include other items such as windows, toys, plastic bags, tubing, etc.

How: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together.

When: The current schedule can be found on the Borough's website

Spring/Fall Cleanup: Yes, Spring

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Yes, through special arrangements with Tri-County Industries.

Yard Waste (excluding grass): Yes. Consult the schedule on the Borough website.

Christmas Trees: Yes, through January 30. Trees must be at curb by 7 a.m. on each Monday.
